



BODEGAS FUSIÓN – D.O. RIBERA DEL DUERO

A partnership of passion and the love for wine. Fernando, sommelier and winemaker, owns a subterranean 15th century cellar, deep below the town of Aranda de Duero. Cristina runs a specialized wine tourism agency in Spain.

Bodegas Fusión, the realization of a dream, is determined to make a high quality wine from Tempranillo, the native variety of Spain and of Ribera del Duero that expresses the essence of the land. They look for elegance and finesse and using the latest technology to achieve a perfect balance in the wines, in a region that often produced highly-extracted, overly oaked blockbuster wines.

The wines are produced in the bodega of friends who have collaborated in the process, in anticipation of the building of their own winery.

The vineyards are located in La Horra and Gumiel de Mercado and in Peñafiel in the heart of the region. Stony calcareous soils provide excellent ripening and the most elegant tannins and minerality. The vines are 40 to 100 years old and are 100% Tinto Fino as Tempranillo is known locally.

The name Lara O is a present for Lara, Fernando's sister, "the best gift with no words to thank her for her patience and support in this project."

When I first tasted the wine (Lara O Pro) after having just submerged from the underground tunnels and cellars, I was struck by the freshness and finesse and the depth of flavour. For the first time in Canada, don't miss this small allocation of very special wines.
